Package 1 - The Basic Postpartum

One 3-hour visit per week for one month after your baby/ babies have arrived to help with the new transition and routine.

Package 2 - The Comfy Postpartum

Two 3-hour visits per week, for one month after your baby/ babies have arrived, giving you a good opportunity to transition into your new routine and feel supported on your journey.

Package 3 - The Deluxe Postpartum

Three 3-hour day support visits and one 8-hour night support visit per week for one month following the arrival of your baby/ babies, helping you to feel rested, fully supported, and ready to fully embrace your new routine and transition.

Closing the Bones Ceremony

The Closing the Bones ceremony can usually last up to 2 hours.

The Closing the Bones ceremony will be done in the first session of 3-Step Rewind, which can last up to 3 hours. The second and third 3-Step Rewind sessions will be done virtually, unless agreed otherwise.

Pregnancy Reiki

Reiki during labour and birth can be used to support challenges including labour induction, pain management, retained placenta, fear, and much more.

3-Step Rewind Trauma Resolution

A gentle, safe but very effective process to lift trauma from previous perinatal experiences and to support you in feeling more hopeful and positive about your current journey. 3-Step Rewind can be done either in-person or virtually but one must allow themselves space and time alone without distraction for the full sessions.

What is included in your birth doula package?

The following is information about what you will receive as a birth doula client.

1. Initial Consultation

The first thing that will happen once you contact Globebaby Doula is that you will be offered an initial consultation. This consultation usually lasts anywhere from 20 to 30 minutes and is done over the phone or via video chat on WhatsApp or Zoom. Occasionally, if scheduling allows, I will meet you face to face for the initial consultation. The aim of this consultation is to see if we, together, will make a good team. For this consultation, I will ask you some questions and I advise that you have some questions prepared to ask me too.

2. Prenatal Visits

If we have both decided that we will make a good team for your birth, we will go forward and schedule your prenatal visits. At the first visit we will discuss your birth plan, gather information for making the best choices for you, address any fears or concerns that you may have, and discuss how we can work together as a team. During the second visit, we will review your birth plan, discuss any new concerns that may have arisen, review the signs and stages of labor and what to expect in the postpartum period, prepare a postpartum plan, discuss newborn care, and feeding management. Each prenatal visit lasts approximately one hour.

3. On-going text, phone, and email support

I will be available to support you via text, phone and/ or email during business hours (9am to 5pm) from the moment you sign our contract until 3 months postpartum. I will answer any questions you may have to the best of my knowledge and will provide you with evidence based resources when possible. If I am unable to advise you, I will refer you to a professional who can.

If I cannot take your call, I will send you a message and schedule when I can return your call. Alternatively, you can send me a brief message detailing the reason for your call. That way I will be more able to properly support you upon returning your call.

4. Continuity of Care

As a self-employed individual, I will be working for you; not for your hospital or Health Provider. This means that your priorities are my priorities. During your prenatal months, we will build our relationship based on trust and support. This trusted relationship will help you feel more secure, confident and respected within the hospital environment and at a time of significant transition. It also assures that there will be a familiar and



understanding presence during the postpartum period to review your birth story with, support with feeding, and provide newborn care information.

5. On-call labor and birth support from 38 weeks gestation

Once you decide to call me, I can labor with you at home, or over the phone, until it is time to transition to the hospital and accompany you to whichever hospital you have chosen. I can also meet you at the hospital - whichever option works better for you. You decide when you need me to come and offer you support and comfort. I will support you (and your birth partner) throughout your labor and birth, utilizing whichever methods you have described in your birth plan and I will be prepared to continue supporting you both if your birth plan changes. I offer various comfort measures including, but not limited to, massage, breathing guidance, suggestions for positioning, a peanut ball, acupressure, general hands on healing and comfort for you and your partner.

My main purpose as your doula is to provide non-judgemental support for you in ALL of your choices and to provide information so that you and your partner can make informed decisions.

Each birth package includes a set amount of hours allotted to supporting you. Additional hourly rates of €35 are applied after the specified times in the package that you have chosen.

6. Cesarean Birth

Should a cesarean be part of your plan, or should you need an emergency cesarean, I will be there for you from the moment you reach the hospital. I will accompany you to surgery (as long as it is permitted in hospital policy) and remain with you for up to 3 hours afterwards. I will also visit you during your hospital stay. The Cesarean Birth Support Package also includes 18 hours of postpartum care which may be used at your discretion; overnight care in blocks of 8 hours or more, daytime care in blocks of 3 hours or more.

7. Photos

I can take some photos at your labor and birth, if you would like me to. I will later send these photos to you via WhatsApp at no extra charge (unless you have chosen professional photography with me). I may want to use some of your pictures for marketing and social media purposes. If you agree with this, I will have you sign an agreement form beforehand. Again, I support your decision to consent to or decline this.

8. Postpartum Visits

Postpartum visits last for a minimum of three hours. In our first visit, we will debrief about your birth and you and your partner's experience, should you wish. We will also discuss how I, as your doula, served your family, if I was your birth doula. I can offer support with newborn care including bathing, feeding (bottle, breast, combination, or



pump), comforting, sitting with you, chatting with you, do some light housework, prepare some light meals, or offer sibling support.

During all other postpartum visits, I will be there as a support person for you, aiming to lessen the overwhelm you may be feeling by doing some light housework, preparing some light meals, or simply just being there to offer you company and a person to chat to.

We can also discuss any postpartum issues that may arise to which I can provide referrals for further professional assistance, if needed.

9. Overnight Support Visits

Overnight visits will consist of 8-hour blocks where I come to your home and watch the baby while you and your partner get some well needed rest. I will discuss with you beforehand what you would like me to do when your baby needs feeding or comforting during the night and I will follow your directions. We will also come to an arrangement on my arrival and departure from your home. I *may* need a short rest during your overnight support too. This will be mutually discussed and agreed upon beforehand.

10. Sibling support

Siblings need support too! It is a significant transition from being a little to becoming a big. I can help make the transition go more smoothly with loving support for your children as you adjust to life with a new baby. With 12+ years of teaching experience, I can naturally cater to your older children's needs and entertain them at age appropriate levels.



What is included in your postpartum doula package?

The following is information about what you will receive as a postpartum doula client.

As your Postpartum Doula, I will assist you in transitioning from the initial feelings of overwhelm, exhaustion and uncertainty to feeling more calm and confident in your parenting journey. I will get you the resources and support you with the skills you will need in those early days.

As your Postpartum Doula, I will:

Understand:

I will hold space for you with understanding, empathy and compassion and without judgment as you navigate the transition to parenthood/parenting an additional child.

Care:

I will nurture you and your family through light meal preparations. I will facilitate your sleep, do some light housework, run simple errands, and look after older children (package dependent).

Inform and Educate:

I will provide you with information and resources around newborn care, baby feeding whether breast, bottle, combination, or pump, self-care and perinatal mood disorders and anxiety. Should anything be outside of my scope, I will offer referrals to the appropriate professionals.

Support:

I will support your parenting choices and never offer judgment or try to force my parenting skills on you. This is your journey and I will support you all the way.

Provide on-going text, phone and email support:

Parenting doesn't come with a schedule and I understand that. Therefore, I will offer on-going support via text, phone and/ or email during business hours for the first three months postpartum.
